GLOBAL STUDY PROGRAM APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY-** In order to apply to the UC Davis Global Study Program (GSP) students must be attending a partner university and meet the specified admission criteria. Eligible students will be selected for nomination into the program per the internal selection process of their home university.
- 2. Eligible students must complete an **online** application for GSP. The application can be found at this link: https://cie.ucdavis.edu/applications/global-study-program-application.

IMPORTANT APPLICATION TIPS

- 1) When creating "My Profile" page, only complete the required fields marked with a red asterisk [*]
- 2) Only capitalize the first letters of your name and home addess. Ex: "John Smith"
- 3) Remember to enter your date of birth
- 4) Don't forget your room number if you live in a dormitory or apartment
- 5) Please name your attached files in English, such as "transcript," "passport," "TOEFL score," "financial statment," respectively. We will NOT be able to open them otherwise.

- 3. Applicants **must submit all** of the following supplemental documents online:
 - a. Official copy of most-recent home university transcript
 - b. Copy of a passport photo page
 - c. Official report of English language scores
 - d. Financial Statement
 - i. This statement must be from a bank, sponsor, or credible institution confirming that sufficient funds are available for the program's duration. These funds must exceed the total estimated expenses. The statement must be in English, on bank letterhead and be dated within the last 90 days.

IMPORTANT: If the statement is from a parent, family member, or other personal sponsor, a letter from that parent/family member/sponsor should accompany the statement which states that he/she is willing to support the student while he/she attends school here.

- ii. Students are required to show sufficient funds for **both** tuition and living expenses for the duration of the program. The required estimated living expenses for the Global Study Program are **\$4,147 U.S. dollars per academic quarter** (Academic Year 2021-2022).
- 4. All applicants are reviewed by the Global Study Program Board and admissions decisions are made.
- 5. Partner universities and applicants are notified of admissions decisions and welcome materials are mailed to the students. This usually occurs within one month of the application deadline.
